



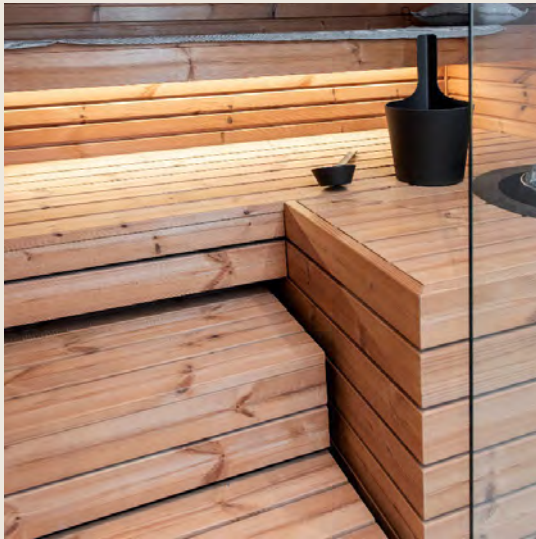

Hygienic, do not absorb water or dirt. Easy to care and maintain.



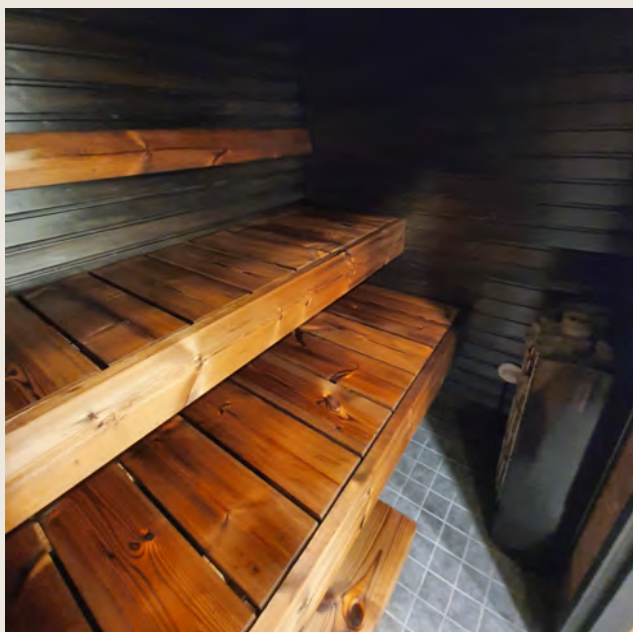

Desing and installation aspects

In desing phase

- Proper ventilation in sauna
- Fire safety and safety areas around the stove
- Drainage and slopes
- Insulation and air & vapour tightness
- Cleaning of the sauna during the use

Panelling

- Ensure there is a ventilation gap behind the panels
- Install the panels with the grooved edge facing downward
- Plan the installation order of the ceiling and walls carefully to achieve a clean, visually pleasing result
- No corner trims are needed for a seamless finish

Maintenace and care of Lunawood in sauna

- For hygienic reasons we recommend treating all Lunawood surfaces with **paraffine oil**. It will protect against dirt and moisture, facilitate cleaning and enliven the wood surface.
 - Wipe the wooden parts clean of dust, clean them with a sauna detergent or other detergent suitable for wooden surfaces, and allow to dry.
 - For paraffine oil, the surface must be clean and dry.
 - Follow the paraffine oil manufacture's instructions
- Allow the surfaces to dry after sauna session by ensuring good ventilation in the sauna room. We recommend leaving the stove on for at least half an hour with the air vent open and the door and windows closed.

General guidance for maintenance

1. **Treat new benches with paraffin oil:**

Applying paraffin oil helps protect the wood from moisture and dirt. Use a sponge or cloth to apply the oil, and reapply as needed.

2. **Clean benches regularly:**

Wash the benches a few times a year, starting from the underside where dirt accumulates. Use a soft brush and, if possible, remove detachable parts for easier cleaning. Don't forget to clean the bench frame attached to the wall. Dry by heating the sauna.

3. **Use mild cleaning agents:**

Avoid chlorine-based cleaners, as chlorine vapor is toxic when heated.

4. **Dry benches properly after use:**

Minimize excessive water exposure and always dry the benches after use. Leave the electric stove on for 30 minutes or add firewood to the wood-burning stove. Keep the door closed and the air vent open.

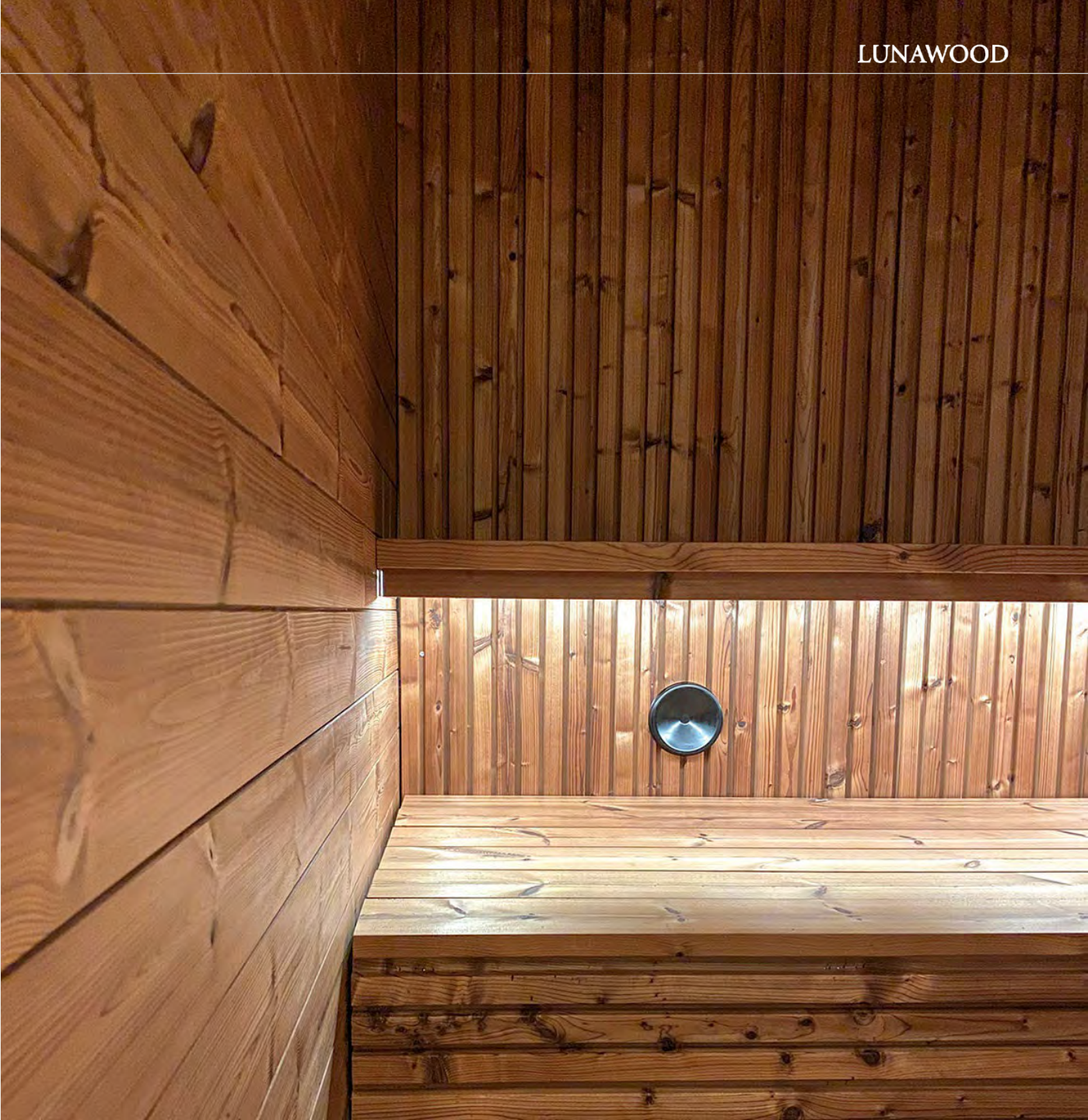
